SÃO BENEDITO CHURCH

It was the first church built in the southern region of Brazil by black slaves devoted to São Benedito, believed to have been built around 1600 to 1650, the "Glorious São Benedito."

RACHEL COSTA THEATER

Former Veiga Family mansion, built in 1938. After being abandoned, the property was acquired by the City of Paranaguá, and after restoration, the Cine theater was erected. Currently with 530 seats, it hosts courses, performances, concerts, plays, and screenings of popular and cultural films.
